Subject: Prepop data posted and Notice of Changes to HUD-52722 Prepopulated Data

Good morning. This message notifies PHAs that HUD posted the CY 2018 prepop data, which is available at the 2018 Op Sub web site at the following URL:

https://www.hud.gov/program_offices/public_indian_housing/programs/ph/am/of/opfnd2018.

This message also notifies PHAs that HUD deleted data that would otherwise have been pre-populated in the CY 2018 HUD-52722 Tools for certain projects. Normally, HUD pre-populates rolling base data in the HUD-52722, using data submitted by the PHA in the prior year. In CY 2018, HUD removed pre-populated data from the Rolling Base, for certain utility types, including:

- **Non-conforming utility types.** This includes utility types that are missing or misspelled, and utility types, such as Fire Protection and Security Lights, that are not included in HUD's pre-defined utility types.
- **Non-conforming units of measure.** This includes units of measure that are missing or misspelled, or units of measure that are incorrect on the face of it, such as Gas expressed in Gallons or Water expressed in Months.
- **Zero-value in Line 18.** This represents base utility expense levels reported with a zero-value in Line 18 of the HUD-52722. Elimination of this data, because it had a zero value, did not impact the development's UEL PUM.

These changes affect 429 total PHAs and 929 total projects. 629 of the 929 projects had a zero value in line 18, and their elimination from the pre-pop data does not impact funding. PHAs should review the remainder of the affected projects and directly input corrected utility data into their CY2018 submission as appropriate and further noted below.

If a PHA plans to use an eliminated utility in their CY 2018 submission, the PHA must reenter that utility and associated data, including the rolling base, being careful to select the appropriate utility type and unit of measure. If the appropriate utility type or unit of measure does not exist, the PHA can use the "Other" category. Refer to the HUD-52722 electronic tool User Guide on creating a new utility.
